Field Hockey Canada is a strategic organization that works together with the Government of Canada, Coaching Association of Canada, Commonwealth Games Association, the Canadian Olympic Association, FIH and other partners to advance hockey both domestically and internationally.

This opportunity is a full time position based in Vancouver, British Columbia.

This position includes but is not limited to the following key areas of responsibility:

- coaching Canada's high performance athletes for and in international competition;
- coordinate the management, monitoring and evaluation of athlete training programs;
- provide leadership to the athletes and staff involved in the national team programs;
- evaluate and provide *evidence based* feedback for athletes;
- prepare and implement competition and game plans;
- assist with the preparation of reports on the progress of the athletes and program when required, e.g., Athlete Assistance Program (AAP), Canadian Sport Review Panel (CSRP), Sport Canada, etc.; and
- with the national office and national team coordinator support, assist with the management of national team operations.

The preferred applicants will have Level 4 NCCP certification (or the equivalent).

The salary will be commensurate with qualification and experience and will include an employee benefit package. The expected starting date is March 1, 2009 (to view the Men's Pan Am Cup in Chile). Qualified applicants are invited to submit their applications and resume, with salary expectations, in confidence prior to January 16, 2009:
