



**Men's Junior National Regional Identification Camps
For 2013 Junior World Cup & Qualifier
Vancouver May 7/8/9, Calgary June 25/26/27, Toronto TBA**

A formalized Junior National Team Program is a strategic initiative for Field Hockey Canada. The identification camps represent the initial phase of this program and will be followed by a National Junior Camp to select an initial national squad later this summer. More detail about this initiative will follow as part of Field Hockey Canada's Men's High Performance Strategy.

Camp Ages

- Athletes must be born in 1991 or later
 - Athletes born in 1991 can participate in the Qualifier in 2012
 - Athletes from in 1992 can participate in both the Qualifier and the Junior World Cup

Objectives of the Camp are to:

- Evaluate the fitness & performance of athletes attending the camp
- Identify a group of players to lead Canada through the 2013 Junior World Cup Qualifier and Junior World Cup
- Rank players and communicate junior national team performance requirements

Criteria for Participation & Selection:

The criteria used to select players by to the camp and squads are:

- Top athletes who could perform at squad level, or show strong potential to play for the Junior National Team during the 2013 Junior Cycle
- Athletes are expected to run the Canadian Beep set and achieve a minimum standard of level 12 (potential selection criteria to determine further eligibility for participation throughout the camp weekend).
- Eligible athletes for this camp should be identified by their Provincial Association or Club Coach

Camp Costs:

- Camp Cost is \$25 Payable to 'Field Hockey Canada' at the field on the first day of Camp

Travel:

Each athlete is responsible for their own accommodation, transportation and meals while at the Camp.

Registration deadline is May 5th 2010 for the Vancouver Camp, June 23rd 2010 for the Calgary Camp and TBA for the Toronto Camp. Please register by completing the
